ROOM SERVICE MENUS

GENERAL INFORMATION

AIR-CONDITIONING

This is only effective if all windows and doors are closed. When using the remote control, the unit will beep to notify you that it has received the command. If the electricity goes off, the air-conditioning units will automatically shut off and therefore will need re-starting.

The recommended temperature is 23° C/ 73.4° F. If you experience challenges with your remote control, please call Reception.

BEACH VENDORS

Beach vendors are generally friendly, however please do not encourage them onto the property. Those selling massages often use raw aloe which will result in irreparable damage to personal clothing and beach towels. Do ask reception for assistance in arranging boat trips and other activities. We thank you for supporting our efforts to preserve the tranquility of our beach.

BRIDGETOWN

The capital of Barbados, Bridgetown, is known for its British Colonial architecture and its Garrison which are UNESCO World Heritage sites. It is home to the oldest Parliament Building in the western hemisphere and the oldest Synagogue, which dates back to 1654.

CAR PARKING

Please observe the 'No Parking' signs around the property. Guests with hired cars may park in the car park located underneath the tennis court. If you have a special need to park closer, due to a walking disability, kindly inform Reception.

CHECK OUT

We will reconfirm your travel requirements with you the day prior to your departure. For your convenience, a statement of account will be delivered to your room to allow you to review it at your leisure. When settling your account, it is advisable that you allow ample time in the event your credit card needs additional authorisation as this process can sometimes be lengthy. Check out is by 12:00 noon, we ask that you be punctual in vacating your room. Should you have a late flight and would like to request a later departure, please contact Front Desk as early as possible and we will try our best to provide you with the use of a hospitality room.

CHILDREN

Upon arrival families would have received an information letter advising of the services we offer. Babysitting or Nanny services can be arranged with Reception. To avoid disappointment, please make arrangements at your earliest convenience.

CURRENCY

Our room rates are quoted in US Dollars. The hotel bill and all prices are presented in Barbados Dollars. We are required to convert the total bill from Barbados Dollars to US Dollars for payment. Exchange Rate: US \$1.00 is equivalent to BDS \$1.98. Other legal tender accepted at the hotel includes Canadian Dollar, Pound Sterling and Euros. Daily published rates are available from the Front Desk.

DEPARTURES

We will reconfirm your travel requirements with you the day prior to your departure. For your convenience, a statement of account will be delivered to your room to allow you to review at your leisure. When settling your account, it is advisable that you allow ample time in the event your credit card needs additional authorisation as this process can sometimes be lengthy.

DEPOSITS

In the event of departure before your scheduled departure date, you will be charged 50% of your remaining stay.

DRINKING WATER

Barbados has one of the purest fresh water supplies in the world, meaning you can safely drink the tap water anywhere. Fresh chilled drinking water is provided in the pitcher in your room daily by your Room Attendant.

ELECTRICITY

Electricity in Barbados is 120 volts 50 cycles. If you require adaptors for 220/240 volts, please enquire at Reception.

EMERGENCY

In the event of an emergency, please call Reception, dial 0. For medical emergencies, see Medical Services. In the unlikely event evacuation is required, make your way to Reception and assemble on the driveway in front, the Primary Assembly Point. Should this area not be safe, please go to the driveway outside the covered car park, the Secondary Assembly Point.

FIRE & SAFETY

Throughout the property there are manual Fire Alarm boxes mounted on the wall for use in emergencies. These are normally red in color with a 'break glass' or polycarbonate front plate. Fire extinguishers are located strategically throughout the buildings. They are conveniently positioned either in the main entrance lobby of the rooms or in easily accessible locations. Fire hoses are located on the landings of multi storey buildings within a cabinet marked 'Fire Hose'.

GARDENS

There are no snakes or harmful creepy crawlies to fear. If you see a squirrel-like animal, you have probably seen a Mongoose. If you see two, you have seen Mongooses! We invite you to join our weekly Garden Tour at 3:45 p.m. every Wednesday. Please book with Reception.

GUEST COMMENTS

As a family run hotel, we receive many comments and compliments verbally which help guide us and maintain our high standards so that we may provide you with a memorable holiday. We welcome your feedback and encourage you to complete the questionnaire found either online, or in your stationary tray, prior to departure. We appreciate the time you take to let us know how we may better serve you.

HOLETOWN

Holetown is the historic site of the first settlers to Barbados in 1625. Just a 15 minute walk away, it offers a great range of facilities and entertainment. From Limegrove Lifestyle Centre with its boutiques and cinema, to the restaurants and bars in First and Second Streets, and the pretty Chattel Village with its charming shops.

INSECTS

Mosquitoes can sometimes be troublesome, although generally not a problem. If they should be a nuisance please feel free to ask your Room Attendant to spray your room for you. Keeping mosquito screens closed whilst windows are open is recommended. Insect repellents are available from the boutique if necessary.

MEDICAL SERVICES

In case of a medical emergency please dial 0 for Reception for assistance in contacting a doctor, day or night. Sandy Crest is a medical centre in Holetown, just 5 minutes away. To call directly, dial 419-4911. Doctors are available for hotel visits. The Queen Elizabeth Hospital is located in Bridgetown, half an hour away. Dial 511 or QEH ambulance service.

PAYMENT METHOD

Settlement may be made by credit or debit card or cash. Coral Reef Club accepts Visa, MasterCard and American Express.

SAFES

Personal safes are provided in each room. We recommend that you use it for securing your valuables. Coral Reef Club's liability for items in safe keeping is limited by law.

SECURITY

For your added safety and security, please ensure that you lock your room when exiting and prior to retiring for the evening. For the safe keeping of your personal possessions, please do not leave valuables unattended around the property, on your patio or on the beach. The hotel cannot accept responsibility for any lost or damaged items. Our Security team patrols the grounds 24 hours a day.

SERVICE CHARGE & GOVERNMENT TAX

Your daily Room Rate, Restaurant, Spa, Wine and Bar charges include 10% Service Charge, and Government Product Development Levy (PDL) VAT. Service charge is distributed amongst all staff. Employees are permitted to accept additional gratuity should you feel that you have received special attention that warrants rewarding, however it is not expected.

THE SANDPIPER

You are welcome to visit our sister hotel, The Sandpiper, just a 10 minute beach or roadside stroll away. For your convenience you may sign any charges to your room there.

SMOKING

Barbadian law prohibits smoking in public areas that are enclosed or partially enclosed. Smoking is also prohibited in our guest accommodations. A cleaning fee will be levied against your account if smoking is detected within your room. Smoking is permitted however, in the gardens, on the beach, on the pool deck and also on the open air terrace around the Reef Restaurant and Bar. Should you wish to smoke on your patio we ask that you close your patio doors to prevent the odor contaminating your room.

TRANSPORTATION

Taxis are readily available. To book please call Reception on Ext. 2210. Rates vary between regular taxis and luxury vehicles. (eg. Mercedes, BMW). Please specify when booking if a luxury vehicle is required. Minivans will charge a higher rate when carrying larger numbers.

GUEST SERVICES

CAR RENTAL

Reception will be pleased to arrange your car rental. You will need to have a current driving licence to enable the rental company to obtain your temporary Barbadian permit.

CONCIERGE/RECEPTION

Reception is open 24 hours a day and is at your service to assist with all enquiries. Dial Ext. 2210 or 2214.

HAIRDRESSING SALON

Located in the Coral Arms building, hairdressing services are provided for both ladies and gentlemen. For appointments telephone 422-3207.

LAUNDRY, DRY CLEANING & PRESSING SERVICES

Same Day Service or 3 Day Service is available. Please place laundry and dry cleaning with completed form into a laundry bag, located in your closet. Arrange collection with your Room Attendant or call the Linen Room on Ext. 2258, 8:00 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. An iron and ironing board are also provided within your closet. For best cleaning results we recommend you indicate the location of particular stains on the form, along with any other specific instructions.

MEET & GREET AND FAST TRACK

For your added convenience we are happy to book Meet and Greet Services for our guests at Grantley Adams International Airport. Those choosing this service will be met by a representative within the arrivals hall and assisted to their waiting taxi. A Fast Track Service is also available whereby a representative will escort you through the shortest line in the Immigration Hall. Please contact Reception or Reservations to ask about booking these services for future visits.

ROOM ATTENDANT

Servicing of rooms commences at 9:00 a.m. Please make use of your 'Do Not Disturb' sign should you wish to enjoy a lie in. Your 'Request for Service' sign will be noted and we will do our utmost to meet your requirements. Evening 'Turn Down Service' is between 6:30 p.m. and 9:30 p.m.

SPA TREATMENTS

A team of skilled therapists perform a wide range of massages, facials, wraps, scrubs, manicures and pedicures.

SPA GIFT CERTIFICATES

Personalised Gift Certificates, elegantly gift wrapped, are available for all Spa Treatments. Certificates are valid for six months and are non-transferable.

SPA RETAIL PRODUCT LINES

The Spa features Natura Bissé, award winning facial and body products from Barcelona and The Spa, Signature Collection from Barbados. Also available for purchase are monogrammed Spa bath robes.

SPA MEDICAL INFORMATION

All Spa guests must provide up to date medical details prior to treatments and or use of the Thermal Spa Garden, specifically relating to allergies, skin conditions, pregnancy and serious medical conditions. All information is treated confidentially.

SPA DRESS CODE

Robes and spa slippers are provided by The Spa, along with disposable underwear for certain treatments. Nudity is prohibited therefore swim suits must be worn and topless sunbathing for ladies is not permitted.

YOGA

Classes are held in the Spa overlooking the Courtyard Garden on Tuesday and Thursday mornings between 8:00 a.m. and 9:15 a.m. Space is allocated on a first-come first-served basis.

SAFES

Personal safes are provided in each room. We recommend that you use it for securing your valuables. Coral Reef Club's liability for items in safe keeping is limited by law.

VALUABLES

It is recommended that valuables are left in the safe within your accommodation. The Spa cannot be held responsible for any lost or damaged items.

MOBILE PHONES

To preserve the peace and tranquility we ask that you set your mobile phone on silent and kindly refrain from taking calls as the use of mobile phones is not permitted in the Spa or the Spa Gardens.

SPORTS & LEISURE

BEACH

There is a coral reef submerged just below the surface of the sea directly opposite the Reception which is excellent for snorkelling. A swimming area to the right of the beach, with a private raft anchored for your enjoyment, is clearly marked by buoys and is perfect for swimming. A shower is provided at the beach front and by the main pool for your convenience. Do remember to take your belongings with you when retiring from the beach.

BEACH & CHAISE LOUNGES

A Beach Butler will be happy to assist with your needs on the beach. There is an adequate supply of chaise lounges for all guests and reserving of such is strictly prohibited. Please ask for assistance in finding one if required. Should you be leaving the beach or pool please take your towel and belongings with you. Items left on unused sunbeds for over 2 hours will be removed by a Beach Attendant. Please return your beach towels to your room so that they may be replaced.

CATAMARAN CRUISES

Catamaran cruises can be arranged through Reception. Join up with others or go on your own private cruise. Viewing the Island from a different perspective and even taking in a swim with the turtles is a wonderful way to spend part of the day.

CAUTION

We have a plethora of indigenous wildlife in Barbados. In our gardens, Green Monkeys roam freely, and although charming to look at, we recommend you enjoy watching their antics from a safe distance. Most importantly, please do not feed them. In the sea, microscopic sea organisms known as 'Sea Lice' sometimes live on the ropes which link the buoys and can cause a sting or rash, not dissimilar to nettle rash. Do take care around these ropes. Should you venture over the reef look out for sea urchins. There are harmless but painful if trodden upon. We recommend you see a bar waiter should you step on one. The remedy involves lime juice and hot candle wax!

CELLPHONE

As we strive to maintain Coral Reef Club's relaxed holiday ambience, we request that guests refrain from taking or making cell phone calls in the Restaurant or in the Cocktail Lounge.

FISHING

Deep sea game fishing can be arranged through Reception. Fishing local 'style', with live bait and hand lines, may also be organised with our local fisherman contacts. Although creature comforts are basic, this sport is quite entertaining!

FITNESS CENTRE

Our Fitness Centre, open daily between 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m., is equipped with Life-Fitness machines. A Personal Trainer can be booked with Reception. Please wear appropriate attire and use a towel while on equipment for hygiene purposes. The gym is unsupervised and children under 14 are not permitted without an accompanying adult.

GAMES

Cards, puzzles, backgammon sets are available. Please enquire with Reception.

GRENADINE ISLAND TOURS

A memorable day of sailing through the unspoiled coral islands and atolls of the Grenadines on board a private catamaran can be arranged through our Reception Desk.

GOLF

Royal Westmoreland is a Robert Trent Jones Jr. course and is admired for its degree of challenge and dramatic scenery. Golf carts are compulsory on this course and only rubber studs are permitted. The club house will change metal studs to rubber, should it be necessary.

Sandy Lane Golf Course, a Tom Fazio course, also offers a challenging round. Golf Carts, caddies and trolleys are all available for hire.

Apes Hill Club, the newest golf course on the island, is set amidst lush grounds, coral stone quarries, wooded ravines and sparkling lakes. Many tees are elevated to enjoy stunning views of both the West and East coasts.

The Barbados Golf Club, situated in Christ Church, is a 35 minute drive away and offers a more affordable, country style, 18 holes.

Reservations can be made through our Reception.

HORSEBACK RIDING

Enjoy a ride through the countryside and cane fields down to the East Coast, beginners and advance riders alike. Reception will be happy to make your booking.

JET SKIS

These craft are not the property of Hightide Watersports or Coral Reef Club. Their use is restricted around beaches and they must be used at least 200 meters offshore. For safety reasons they can only approach and leave the beach through designated channels. Craft must not be operated in swimming or snorkelling areas marked by buoys. Please take great care if using them as many are not insured and the hotel accepts no responsibility or liability in the event of challenges. We recommend you only use jet skis with registration numbers. Should you have reason to complain, kindly make note of the number and advise Management.

NEWSPAPERS

We deliver a complimentary local newspaper, The Advocate, daily to your room. International newspapers and internet printed papers may be ordered through the Casual Boutique or Reception if outside of opening hours.

POOLS

There are two swimming pools. The main pool is located south of the Reception building and the other is by Tamarind Villa. Our Pools are not supervised and bathers under the age of 12 are not allowed in the pool unless accompanied by a person of 16 years or over. Some accommodations have private plunge pools and these are for the exclusive use of their occupants. Diving is strictly prohibited in all pools. A shower and foot bath are located at the entrance of the Main Pool for your convenience.

ROUGH SEAS

On rare occasions the sea can be rough with strong currents. At these times you will be warned by RED FLAGS which are placed on the beach to advise caution. When conditions are very rough please do not swim in the sea as it is dangerous.

SCUBA DIVING

We are fortunate to have beautiful reefs lying under our waters with an impressive array of coral growth. Fully certified dive courses are available through Hightide Watersports Tel: 432-0931 or Ext. 2326. Wreck, Reef and Open Water Dives are also available.

SUN EXPOSURE

Be warned, the sun is very strong between 11:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. so take extra care during this time. Remember to apply sunblock regularly and stay hydrated.

SURFING, WINDSURFING & KITE SURFING

For experienced surfers there are a number of good surfing breaks around the island. For enthusiasts interested in riding the waves, Surfing, Windsurfing and Kite Surfing lessons can be arranged on the windier South Coast. Reception will be pleased to assist with arrangements.

SWIMMING

There is a buoyed system demarking the swimming area from the reef, and a private raft located within this area for relaxing and sunbathing. Should you require additional assistance, just notify the Watersports team in advance and they will be glad to help.

TENNIS

There are two tennis courts, one high level above the covered car park, and one just beyond the Tamarind pool. We offer a complimentary Tennis Clinic which is coached by an international tennis pro, Monday to Saturday, between 4:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. Younger players are asked to play in the earlier hour, from 4:00 p.m. Courts are floodlit for night play. To book a court, please do so through Reception, Ext. 2214. The Tennis Courts may be booked only one day in advance, from 7:00 a.m. on the day prior to the booking. Private professional instruction and coaching may also be arranged with Reception.

WALKS & TRAILS

There are a number of interesting nature trails to be enjoyed including a weekly National Trust hike. The Flower Forest, Welchman Hall Gully, and Andromeda Gardens, amongst others, offer wonderful botanical experiences. Alternatively you can enjoy a leisurely tour of the Coral Reef Club gardens on Wednesday afternoons at 3:45 p.m. Please contact Reception for more details.

WATERSPORTS

The team from Hightide Watersports will be happy to assist with a wide variety of water based activities. The speedboat can be booked for Waterskiing, Wakeboarding, Big Mable and Donut riding or simply an exhilarating cruise.
